Approach

Participants will receive training and advice on how to run a profitable poultry business. The 2-day training program is highly interactive, and is divided in two parts:

- Day 1 will focus on an introduction to general financial management and basic accounting principles with a focus on the poultry sector. You will get a better understanding of the different costs and how they affect the income of your business.
- On day 2 you will put the learnings from the first day into practice. You will use a financial model that can guide you in running your business. Together we will review various business models in the poultry sector, based on the financial model.

At the end of the workshop, participants have a deeper understanding on how they can control the costs within their business and increase efficiency and profitability of their company.

For commercial broiler, commercial layer and pullet businesses the training will take place on the 27th and 28th of November. The same training will be facilitated for parent stock and day-old chick businesses on the 29th and the 30th of November.
